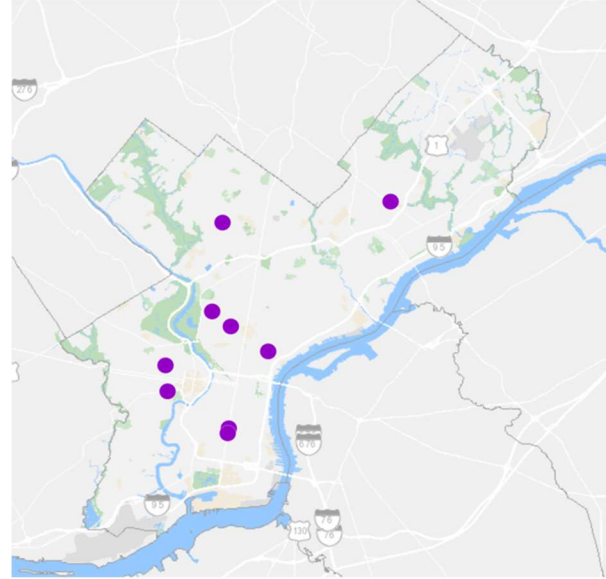

You can apply for health insurance through the Health Insurance Marketplace. Open enrollment for 2023 begins November 1st. If you have lost insurance, you may qualify for a Special Enrollment period. You can call 1-800-318-2596, or visit <https://www.healthcare.gov/get-coverage/> to apply. To receive in-person help with application, visit <https://localhelp.healthcare.gov/#intro>

You may qualify for Medicaid (Medical Assistance) if you have low income
