## RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

### Research Focus

Endoscopic therapy for gastrointestinal neoplasm and novel endoscopic techniques.

Gastric Cancer: I led a multicenter study to assess the risk of lymph node metastasis in early gastric cancer in the United States. This study provides key information on the risk of lymph node metastasis in the US population and can

allow the physician to make the critical decision as to whether a patient can be treated with minimally invasive endoscopic treatment or requires surgical resection, based on the patient's risk of developing metastatic disease. I led a multicenter study involving 25 centers across North America to assess the safety and efficacy of a novel endoscopic resection technique for early gastric neoplasia called endoscopic submucosal dissection, which is superior to the conventional endoscopic resection technique that is commonly performed in the United States.

Novel Endoscopic Approaches: such as (1) a new method of "oversewing" a bleeding or high-risk peptic ulcer using novel endoscopic suturing, which is a safe and effective method for achieving endoscopic hemostasis; (2) endoscopic full-thickness muscle biopsy for rectal tissue sampling in patients with severe gut motility disorders, thus the patient can avoid traditional surgical biopsy.
